NOTICE OF COMMUNITY ZOOM MEETING

MONDAY MAY 11, 2020, 7PM

TO DISCUSS A FEE INCREASE of at LEAST \$75 PER MONTH

- Sufficient funds to deal with current regulatory requirements, rising insurance of aging systems, inflation, airpark management salary and support, maintenance or replacement of aging infrastructure, and any improvements are not now available.
- The funds available for residential street maintenance are not sufficient to avoid predictable future street failures.
- If we are unable to pay our bills, the airport will quickly lose the ability to operate
- Aircraft and businesses will leave, property values will fall and the neighborhood environment will change. This unique neighborhood will be forever gone.
- The county has no interest in keeping this airport and it is unlikely to be purchased by someone interested in operating it as a private airport. It will likely be closed and developed.
- The current level of funding at \$25 per month (\$300 a year) has not increased since 1995.
- We are asking for a minimum of \$75 per month increase, to keep the airport district operating and allow for minimal street maintenance.
